



In My Garden

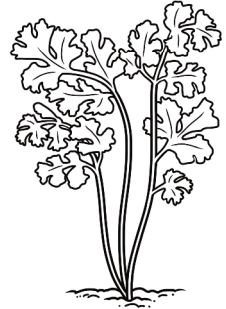

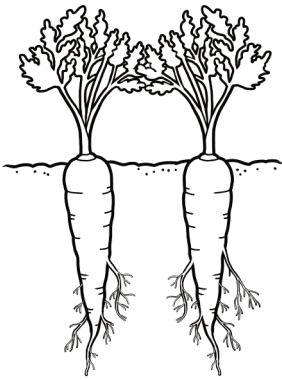

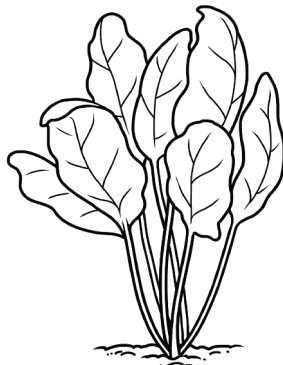

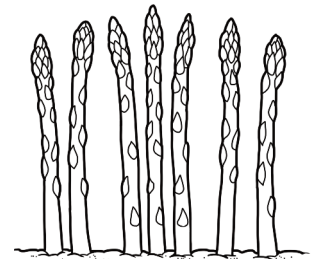
