What is it?

A poem in **free verse** does not have to have any particular pattern of rhythm, rhyme, or structure. Here's an example:

Hiking with My Best Friend

The sun is shining.

We bring bottles of water and nectarines. On the trail, we talk about the things we hear and see:

water rushing over shiny rocks at the bottom of a creek.

squirrels chattering as they scurry up a tree, a bird singing a happy song.

We stop and listen and eat our nectarines. Hiking with my best friend, I feel happy, too.
