





What is it?

A **ballad** is a poem or song with four lines that rhyme. Words that rhyme end with the same sound. For example, dad and add rhyme. In many ballads, the first and third lines rhyme with each other, and the second and fourth lines share a different rhyme. Here's an example:

Making Pizza


I like to help make pizza with my dad. I wash my hands and wash the veggies, too. My dad chops up the veggies, then I add Them on the top. It's so easy to do!
